The GutsMuths year 2009 was declared on New Year' Eve 2008, with the **first annual GutsMuths cross-country run**. From then on, the New Year's run takes place in Waltershausen every year.

When honouring **Johann Christoph Friedrich GutsMuths** (09.08.1759 Quedlinburg – 21.05. 1839 Ibenhain), we equally think of **Christian Gotthilf Salzmann** (01.06. 1744 Sömmerda – 31.10. 1811 Schnepfenthal), one of the forerunners of modern pedagogy and school sports.

In Schnepfenthal, Salzmann set up a philanthropy-approved school, which was committed to the progressive teaching aims of enlightenment. In this school, pupils were taught all day long in subjects such as Geography, History, Religion, French, and English. For the first time Physical Education became a school subject of equal status in Germany!

One year later, Salzmann employed GutsMuths as a teacher in Geography, French, and Gymnastics. He was the author of numerous texts, for example "Gymnastik für die Jugend" (Gymnastics for the Youth), 1793/ 1804 and "Spiele zur Übung und Erholung des Körpers und des Geistes" (Games for the education and relaxation of body and mind), 1796.

GutsMuths' highest achievements:

- 1. German gymnastics and artistic gymnastic ground, starting 1785
- 1. Artistic gymnastics book of the modern world, 1793
- 1. Pedagogical game book of Germany, 1796
- 1. Competitive swimming lessons, starting 1798
- 1. Comprehensive pedagogical magazine, 1800 20
- Reformer of Geography lessons
- Forerunner of new forms of sports in Thuringia, such as pole-vaulting, crosscountry runs, ice skating, Nordic skiing

In an area that is shaped by the beauty of the Thüringen forest, something new was created in 2009- the Year of GutsMuths: On 9 September 2009, we opened

the New GutsMuths Memorial Hall in Schnepfenthal - Sports hall, exhibition, club and training room.

This small GutsMuths Museum devotes itself to themes such as GutsMuths' life and work, regional history and sport, Rennsteiglauf (a cross-country race named after GutsMuths), Zöglingsweg (a hiking route on the tracks of Waltershausen's Philanthropists).

In the open-air area, everyone can test their skills on the reconstructed GutsMuths sports equipment and read the informational plaques about:

the Zöglingshain (trees of the pupils) and Terra Gymnastica (sports equipment). We are open to the public at any time.
